With two dozen courses - including three of the country's Top 100 (Pronghorn, Tetherow, and Crosswater), it is no surprise Golf Digest ranked Central Oregon as one of the Top 25 golf destinations in the world. Central Oregon has courses designed by some of the game's greatest architects like Nicklaus, Fazio, Kidd, Jacobson, Fought, Cupp and Jones. Whether you're looking for Scottish links-style, towering Ponderosa-lined fairways, or pristinely manicured resort play, each course has its own story, and with so many, there's a "bucket list" experience waiting for every level of player.

Central Oregon courses aren't short on scenery. The volcanic landscape of the region — which stretches from the foothills of the Cascades to the High Desert — has naturally forged a canvas with shots that challenge you to carry over deep canyons and the famed Deschutes River; bunkers carved from lava

flows and filled with red sand, and fairways framing the majestic Cascade Mountains.

It may surprise you to learn that with less annual rainfall than San Diego, Central Oregon's sunny, dry and mild temperatures are ideal for golf. Summer day temperatures average in the low 80s, while spring and fall provide crisp mornings and warm evenings for golf lovers. Central Oregon also has several courses that are open year-round.

## AMERICA'S TOP GOLF IN OREGON'S HIGH DESERT.

Central Oregon features three courses in Golf Digest's Top 100 and half of Golfweek's Top 10 courses in Oregon. Better yet? All of the courses are within 45 minutes of each other.

### PRONGHORN

Pronghorn, located 15 minutes east of Bend, sits on 640 acres in the world's second-largest juniper forest has the look and feel of a gated Tuscan village. Pronghorn's Huntington Lodge made Condé Nast Traveler's list of "The Hottest New Hotel Openings of Summer 2019"

Pronghorn is home to two of the region's most highly-acclaimed golf courses. The Jack Nicklaus Signature Course, and the Tom Fazio Course.

The Jack Nicklaus Signature Course delivers a stout test of golf and a great variety of challenges. Play a round that cuts through lava rock outcroppings with signature views of Mount Bachelor, Broken Top, and Three Sisters volcanoes. The course plays fast and firm and features some of the finest putting surfaces in all of Oregon.

The Tom Fazio Course offers more eye candy and adapts to all skill levels. The Signature 8th features a petrified lava tube. The lava rock walls framing the hole are dramatic and seven unique tees offer a variety of distance, angles and mountain views to choose from. which lands this par three as the best on the course, and maybe in the whole state.

### TETHEROW

Tetherow, on Bend's west side, is quickly becoming Central Oregon's most sought after golf experience. Designed by the same architect as Bandon Dunes

and the Castle Course in Scotland, David McLay Kidd, this unique Scottish-links course features imaginative routing lined by fescue grasses flowing magnificently with the natural terrain

Tetherow offers a diverse mix of holes framed by ragged bunkers, knobs and knolls – without Bandon's gale force winds and 90% chance of rain, and is surrounded by panoramic views of Central Oregon's high desert and Cascade Mountains.

Just 7 minutes from The Old Mill District and 20 minutes from Mt. Bachelor, Tetherow is home to a boutique hotel, pool, three restaurants, vacation rental homes and an event pavilion encompassing 700 acres bordering the Deschutes National Forest. Some of the state's best mountain biking singletrack is right out Tetherow's back door.

### CROSSWATER

Tucked away in the stately pines of Central Oregon's high country, south of Bend, Sunriver Resort is regarded as the Northwest's finest year-round vacation. Home to sixty-three holes of golf,

Crosswater is the resort's flagship course. Designed by Bob Cupp, and stretching out 7,600 yards over 600-acres of woodlands and carefully preserved wetlands, Crosswater is a certified Audubon sanctuary and has been a Top 100 course since it opened more than 20 years ago.

The design is traditional heathland style, and the golf course features five tee placements for each hole as well as bent grass fairways and greens. The layout is forgiving off the tee, but a beat from the fairway where approach shots must find shallow, challenging greens. The Deschutes and Little Deschutes Rivers can come into play as many as 7 times during the round.

Home to 63 holes of golf, Sunriver Resort also hosts the Meadows course which pays tribute to the great American courses of the 1920's and 30's with its aesthetic grace meandering along the Deschutes River, and Robert Trent Jones Jr.'s Woodlands course with tree-lined corridors and scenic views of Mount Bachelor. Caldera Links is a nine-hole par 3 where kids under 12 years old play for free with an adult.

## UNMATCHED COURSES. UNTAMED SCENERY.

Beyond the coveted Top 100 courses, the Central Oregon Golf Trail boasts a variety of other scenic and challenging tracks. Explore the tight, tree-lined fairways of Widgi Creek, the railcar bridge at Lost Tracks Golf Club and the red cinder bunkers at Aspen Lakes. Take in beautiful canyon vistas at Crooked River Ranch, or bask in the sun between massive mountains and cityscape at River's Edge in the heart of Bend.

Juniper Golf Course in Redmond has long been a championship-caliber course that's hosted several

Oregon Opens, and Quail Run in Lapine may be one of the state's best-kept secrets.

Black Butte Ranch has drawn visitors to the sunny side of the Cascades for 50 years. The breathtaking mountains loom large over this golf destination community of two amazing courses – Glaze Meadow and Big Meadow. The Brasada Canyons course winds through Brasada Ranch, where guests can explore 1,800 acres with views of nine Cascade Peaks. Tennis courts, horseback riding, pools, and more await at these two Central Oregon destination resorts.

## PLAY MORE GOLF, OR JUST PLAY MORE.

Central Oregon is home to more than just great golf. It is also the nation's premier outdoor recreation destination. Brave the rapids rafting down the Deschutes River, or discover hundreds of miles of bike and hiking trails. The lakes and rivers of Central Oregon are home some of the world's best fishing for trout and steelhead.

Central Oregon is also known for craft beer, and checking out one or two of the region's 26 breweries post-golf is par for the course. Just to name a few, try Deschutes, downtown Bend's oldest brewery, Three Creeks Brewing in Sisters, Crooked River Brewing

in Prineville, Wild Ride in Redmond or 2017 Small Brewing Company of the year, Sunriver Brewing.

Mt. Bachelor, the nation's 6th largest ski area, has one of the longest ski seasons in the country. It's typically open Thanksgiving through Memorial Day, which means you can play golf and ski on the same day.

At Smith Rock State Park, sheer cliffs of tuff and basalt rise vertically from the Crooked River canyon, creating massive red rock walls. Numerous hiking trails and endless photo opportunities await at this majestic site.



## SET FORTH, TO CENTRAL OREGON

Out on the course, surrounded by open skies and mountains in every direction, it doesn't feel close to anywhere. But with 30 daily flights from 11 destinations on 6 carriers, Central Oregon is the get-away that's easy to get to.

Redmond Airport (RDM), 25 minutes north of Bend, now offers non-stop service to **Chicago (ORD)**, **Denver (DEN)**, **Las Vegas (LAS)**, **Los Angeles (LAX)**, **Mesa (AZA)**, **Phoenix (PHX)**, **Portland (PDX)**, **Salt Lake City (SLC)**, **San Diego (SAN)**, **San Francisco (SFO)** and **Seattle (SEA)**.
